**Generic Name:** Lidocaine 4%

**Purpose:** This medicine is used on the skin to cause numbness prior to procedures.

**Usage:** A very thick layer of Ela-Max cream is applied to the skin. This is done 1-2 hours prior to anticipated procedure.

**Possible Side Effects:**

Side effects are uncommon with this medication. However, they may occur and include redness or swelling at the site of treatment, allergic reactions, and lightheadedness, nervous, apprehension, euphoria, confusion, dizziness, drowsiness, or ringing of the ear, blurred or double vision, and vomiting and/or nausea.
