Have these prescriptions filled several days before your surgery.

<u>Zovirax Capsules</u> : This tablet will help prevent fever blisters and should be taken five capsules four times per day starting the day before surgery until the prescription is empty.
<u>Keflex:</u> This is an antibiotic and should be taken one pill four times a day beginning the day before surgery and every day afterwards until the prescription is empty. Do not take day of surgery.
<u>Valium:</u> Take one tablet an hour before bedtime the night before surgery and tw tables the morning of surgery before
<u>Novafed:</u> This pill is to help decrease nasal congestion. Take one pill every twelve hours beginning the day after surgery.
<u>Percocet</u> : Take one or two tablets every four to six hours as needed for pain after surgery.
<u>Compazine:</u> This is a suppository and is for relief of nausea and vomiting. Use one suppository every six hours as needed after surgery.
<u>Theragran-M Vitamins/Vitamin C (1000mg)</u> : These vitamins will help to aid in the healing process. Take one of each vitamin each day beginning two weeks before surgery and every day afterwards for one month.
