Generic Name: Codeine and Iodinated Glycerol

Purpose: This medicine is used to relieve the cough due to colds, influenza

or hay fever. IT is not used for the chronic cough that occurs with smoking, asthma or emphysema or when there is an unusually

large amount of mucus or phlegm with the cough.

Usage: To help loosen mucus or phlegm in the lungs, drink a glass of

water after each dose of this medicine.

Precautions: If your cough has not improved after 7 days or if you have a high

fever, skin rash, continuing headache, or sore throat with the cough, check with Dr. Beeson. This medicine will add to the effects of alcohol and other depressants. Drowsiness or dizziness may occur. Make sure you know how you react to this medicine before you drive, use machines, or do jobs that require to you to be

alert.

Possible Side Effects:

Common side effects include constipation; difficult or painful urination; dizziness or lightheadedness; drowsiness; dryness of mouth, nose, or throat; false sense of well being; and nausea or vomiting. If you notice other effects not listed above, contact Dr.
